**guidelines for the performance of the  
kata- and forms- championship of the  
WJJF-Germany registered society  
at the world games**

These kata and form competitions, which are assigned to the leisure sector, can be held on a national, federal or international level. For the Budo sportsmen and -women of all kinds of Budo arts, they serve the personal challenge in traditional or free styles. This includes all Budo- and Gong-Fu-Arts which are competed with or without weapons.

Therefore, when registering for the championship, detailed information about style, kata or form and weapons used, are essential.

Weapons prohibited under arms regulations or other legislation in the Federal Republic of Germany (for example Nunchaku, Balisong) are not allowed. For teens, no sharp weapons are allowed. Weapons used must be presented to the jury before the event.

Appropriate approvals and classifications are decided by the jury.

With the registration, these guidelines and all decisions of the jury will be acknowledged.

**Kata- and forms rating:**

With the points to be awarded from 1 to 10, tenth points are also possible.

The results are calculated by the independent judges by adding together.

**Important: If the score is equal, there will be a jump-off!**

**With the same score for the third place, the jury can also award the third place twice!**

**Rating criteria:**

The following criteria will be rated:

Etiquette, clothing, posture, safe movement, exact performance of levers and throws, safe handling of weapons, assessed difficulty level, stick to the time limit, technique performance, fluidity, dynamics, harmony, synchronicity.

**The Kata will be accepted for the Dan-exam of the WJJF-Germany for one year.**

**Setting of time standards:**

The following time limits must be adhered to:

Team of two between 3 to 12 minutes.

These times are minimum and maximum times. Any underruns or overshoots can be avenged with a point deduction.

**Awarding of titles**

<u>Youth</u>	12 to 14 years	U15
<u>Youth</u>	15 to 17 years	U18
<u>Adults</u>	18 to 34 years	+18
<u>Adults master</u>	35 years and older	+35

**Katapool:**

Goshin-jitsu-no Kata (Kodokan-and WJJF-version)  
both are rated the same

Nage-no-Kata, Juno-no Kata, Kime-no Kata, Gonose-no Kata

E-Bo-no Kata, Fusegi-no-Kata, Taiiku-no Kata, Katate-dori-no-Kata,  
Nage-Jiu-no-Kata

1. *wooden weapons* Kodaichi-no Kata, Koshiki-no Kata, Nana-Hon-Kumitachi-Kata

2. *metal weapons* Kodaichi-no Kata, Koshiki-no Kata, Jiyu goshin jitsu Kata from Mifune,  
Nana-Hon-Kumitachi-Kata

If there are less than 3 pairs of 1. *wooden* and 2. *metal weapons* in these groups, they will be put together.

Kodokan- and WJJF-version will be rated the same!

Boys and girls or men and women are **not** rated separately! The dress code is the white or black/white Gi, resp. Hakama.
